Infants-8th Grade Student Identification Tags / Parent Car Tag: Shepherd of the Hills continues to take a proactive approach to enhance campus safety for our students. SHLS is proud to provide you with your personal SHLS CAR TAG and student SHLS STUDENT BAG TAGS. We ask that all families display their family ID car tag from their vehicle's rear view mirror. Please tie the bag tags on your child's bags/backpacks. Car line staff will be able to match bag tags with car tags as an additional safety check during car line dismissal. All parents who park on campus are asked to place tags on rear view mirror in order for us to better identify parked cars as parent vehicles. Midweek Lenten Services: March 8, 15, 22, 29, Apr. 5 -12:15 and 6:30 p.m. **This year's Lenten Sermon Series** is "The Art of Living by Faith." The structure and sequence of the series is shaped by the theological contributions of two catechisms of Martin Luther. The selection of this topic is timely for 2017 for two reasons.

Weekend Lenten sermon series: "Shackled by Sin No More!" based on readings from Romans 4-8. A shackle, literally or figuratively, represents a restraint, a loss of freedom. The consequences of sin, particularly death, serve as the ultimate shackle for all people. St. Paul's writings in Romans provide us God's plan for salvation and freedom from our sin and eternal death, enabling all who believe in Jesus Christ to exclaim, "Shackled no more!"

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
