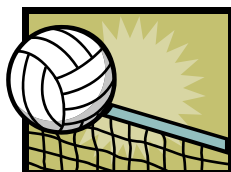
PRINCIPAL GARY'S NOTES

Christians around the world will celebrate a monumental milestone: the 500th anniversary of the Reformation! Oct. 31, 1517 was the day Martin Luther posted a list of theological statements called the 95 Theses on a church door in Wittenberg, Germany. Luther's posting catalyzed a powerful movement, calling the church back to the Gospel. The mantra "faith alone, grace alone, Scripture alone" captures the central message of the Reformation. Our denomination, The Lutheran Church - Missouri Synod, has marketed the 500th anniversary this way: "It's *Still* All about Jesus."

At Shepherd of the Hills, we'll mark the 500th anniversary in special ways the weekend of Oct. 28/29. After all services Saturday and Sunday, refreshments will be served in the lobby.

Our Sunday morning services will have a full arrangement of special music. Thanks to Andrea Melcher and Doug Urban for organizing all of the music; during our music director vacancy, the extra efforts of these two leaders is doubly appreciated! During the Bible class hour that Sunday in the gym, I'll present a visual walk through Luther's life and the Reformation using photos from a trip to Germany that Ashley and I co-hosted with our friends Bruce and Shari Dicey in 2011.
